

Fiji: Ecotourism and Sustainability 2024

The following information is provided only as an estimate of costs associated with this particular study abroad program offered through Discover Abroad with the University of Georgia.

A nonrefundable commitment deposit of \$300 (paid toward the program fee) will be required after you are accepted into the program, due within one week of acceptance. The remainder of the program fee, along with your full UGA Summer tuition and UGA fees, will be billed to your UGA student account after registration, and the total is due to be paid in-full no later than May 11, 2024.

Program fee: \$950

The program fee includes accommodations, international health insurance, in-country ground transportation, and 95% of meals. The program fee also includes unique activities such as snorkeling in the Pacific, a village homestay, and more. The program fee does not include UGA tuition and fees or airfare.

Tuition and UGA fees: ~\$326 per undergraduate credit hour (3 credit hours required)

All students (in-state, OOS, and non-UGA) pay in-state tuition for study abroad at UGA. HOPE and Zell apply to those who are eligible. Non-UGA students who apply for admission as a study abroad transient student will pay a \$75 application fee and an additional \$250 fee if their home institution is not within the SEC or USG network.

Group Airfare: Varies (plus cost of flight from originating airport to LAX and return)

For students participating in one of the Discover Abroad Maymester Australia and New Zealand or Summer Australia programs, there is a relatively inexpensive lay-over en route (to/from LAX). Other students are responsible for arranging their own flight to Nadi, Fiji (which can cost upwards of ~\$1500).

Personal spending: ~\$50

To account only for personal spending on souvenirs, supplementary food, and laundry. Most (95%) meals are covered in the program cost.
